

Tehama District Fair

Junior Livestock Independent Exhibitor Program (For Market Fair Animals Only)

Welcome to the Tehama District Fair Independent Livestock Program. Enclosed please find your requirement forms and record book for the current year. Please make sure that you read the state and local rules for the fair. **These requirements pertain to any independent exhibitor planning to sell a market animal at the Tehama District Fair only.**

Qualification's from State Rules:

- VII.-10 Independent exhibitors must be at least 9 years old by January 1, 2018. Exhibitors are eligible to compete/exhibit through December 31st of the year in which they turn 19 years of age.
- VII-16 Independent exhibitors must enter an open junior and Independent class unless one is not available. If an open or Independent class is not available, junior exhibitors may enter an appropriate 4-H, FFA or Grange class. Division and/or class placement of Independents may be determined by Fair Management.
- VII-17 Juniors who have been 4-H, FFA or Grange project members within 60 days (120 days for horse and market beef) prior to the fair are **not** eligible to compete in that project as Independent juniors or enter project(s) under a different organization.
- VII-18 All junior exhibitors must have a project management records and proof of supervisor available as to the length of project.
- VII-19 Independent junior exhibitors entering market animals must provide Fair Management with a picture of their animal(s), appropriate proof of ownership, permanent tag, tattoo and/or hog ear notch information 120 days prior to the fair for beef, 60 days for sheep, swine and goats and 30 days for chickens and rabbits.
- VII-20 All junior exhibitors must have "on-ground" supervision by a responsible adult.

**NOTE: TEHAMA DISTRICT FAIR IS GOVERNED BY STATE RULES AND MAY IMPOSE
ADDITIONAL LOCAL RULES WHICH SUPERSEDE STATE RULES**

Requirements for eligible Independent Exhibitors are as follows:

- *Must turn in Independent Application signed by both exhibitor and parent due no later than **March 2nd, 2018.***
- ***Mandatory meeting March 5th at 6:00 pm Tehama Room @ Fairgrounds to go over requirements for independents. (Must be present at this meeting to participate at the 2017 Fair)***
- *Picture and Bill of Sale due prior to or the day of tagging:
120 days for steers – March 21, 2018 @ 5 pm – Tehama District Fair
60 days for sheep, goats & swine – May 20, 2018 @ 6 am -TDF
30 days for chickens & rabbits – June 19, 2018*
- *Must attend a Public Meeting between January 1st-June 30th, 2018 and complete the appropriate forms (i.e., City Council Meeting, Fair Board Meeting, Service Organizations, etc.)*
- *Must give a 3 -5 minute presentation in front of an Exhibitor panel (dates to be determined at Mandatory Meeting)*
- *Must complete at least 6 hours of Community Service (not affiliated with 4-H or FFA) with prior approval*
- *Must attend Animal Husbandry/Ethics training, and Fair Exhibitor Meeting provided by Tehama District Fair livestock supervisor*
- *2.0 grade point average must be maintained by Independent. A certified copy of transcripts and GPA must accompany pre-record book check due June 15th. Copy must be in a sealed envelope with school seal*
- *Checklist and pre-record book approval **due** June 15, 2018 by 5:30 pm.*
- *Record Books due no later than Monday July 16th, 2018 by 6:00 pm.*
- *Entry forms must be turned in by June 22nd, 2018.*
- *During Fair week all exhibitors and their adult supervisor must sign in daily at the livestock office by 8:00 am with contact information.*

Exhibitor/ Parent/ Fair Agreement

I, _____ will be participating in the 2018 Tehama District Fair. I agree to abide by all guidelines, local and state rules that govern the Tehama District Fair.

Livestock Department Independent Exhibitors must be at least 9 years of age and must not be older than 18 years of age on January 1, 2018. Exhibitors 4th- 8th grades will show 4-H and 9th - 12th will show FFA.

Ownership Requirements: Independent Exhibitors must meet all ownership requirements. Independent Exhibitors must enter in an open Junior or Independent class unless one is not available. If an open or Independent class is not available, junior exhibitors may enter in an appropriate 4-H, FFA or Grange Class.

Parent/Guardian Signature on the entry form is requirement by the fair to certify that: projects have been under their direct supervision in accordance with the rules and regulations of the fair; and the entry is the project of the exhibitor and is eligible for exhibit. Failure or refusal of parent/guardian to sign the required entry form will prevent the exhibitor from entering that particular class(es).

Leaving an Organization: Juniors who have been a 4-H, FFA or Grange member within 60 days (120 days for horse and market beef) prior to the fair are **not eligible** to compete in that project as an independent junior.

Record Book: All independent exhibitors must have project management records and proof of supervision available as to the length of the project. **Record books are due to the Livestock Supervisor by 6pm on Monday, July 16th. Pre-record book check approval is due June 15th, by 5:30 pm.**

Picture and Bill of Sale: Independent Junior exhibitor entering market animals **must provide** fair management with a picture of their animal, appropriate proof of ownership, permanent ear tag, tattoo and/or hog ear notch information 120 days prior to the fair for beef and 60 days for goat, sheep or swine and 30 days for rabbit and poultry. Mail to TDF, PO Box 70, Red Bluff, CA 96080.

On Grounds Supervision: All independent exhibitors must participate in barn duty. All animals must be fed and watered in a timely manner. Animals not fed or watered in a timely manner will be excused from the fair. All independent exhibitors and adult supervisors must check in with the Livestock Office by 9 am daily during fair week.

Uniform: The show “uniform” for independent exhibitors will be white or navy blue pants, a white collared shirt with sleeves, and closed toed shoes.

Insurance Coverage: Exhibitors may provide insurance coverage. Independent exhibitors may purchase insurance through CFSA. CFSA insurance may be purchased for the *entire family* by submitting a **cashier’s check or money order** for the appropriate amount to TDF.
