2019 JUNIOR MISS TEHAMA COUNTY SCHOLARSHIP PAGEANT

The Tehama County Junior Miss Pageant is an exciting addition to our annual Fair. All contestants, whether successful or not, enjoy the experience of participating in the event and receive a memento of the pageant plus an entry pass to the **2019** Fair.

In addition, the pageant will be a memorable experience filled with lasting memories and new friendships. The pageant will be an opportunity for you to gain poise, self-confidence and to learn the valuable lesson of good sportsmanship

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS & RULES

1. Contestant must be between the age of 9 and not older than 12 as of January 1st of this calendar year.
2. Contestant must be a resident of Tehama County and the State of California for at least one year prior to the opening of the fair.
3. Contestant must complete the official pageant application. Parent or legal guardian must sign all applications.
4. Contestant and/or sponsor(s) shall pay an application fee of \$85.00 per contestant. Fee must accompany the contestant's application. Checks are payable to 30th District Agricultural Association. If sponsored, sponsor(s) will be announced on stage during the contestant's various areas of competition.
5. All applications must be turned into the Tehama District Office no later than 5:00 p.m. on **Thursday, April 20, 2019**.
6. Contestant must agree to abide by all the rules and regulations of the Junior Miss Tehama County pageant and Fair Board rules and regulations. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
7. Junior Miss Tehama County contestants not chosen as Junior Miss Tehama County may compete in following years.
8. Contestant must attend all scheduled practices, unless prior arrangements have been made with the Director.
9. Contestant shall make all appearances for publicity reasons and any other similar type appearances and rehearsals so designated by the pageant director at their expense, unless other arrangements are made.
10. Contestants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0. Transcripts are required with entry form. Junior Miss Tehama County must maintain this minimum GPA during their reign.

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ESSAY QUESTIONS

*On a separate sheet(s) of paper, no more than four pages, answer ALL questions in brief ESSAY FORM. Make sure to include this sheet so that the judges have a reference sheet for the questions. You will lose points if all essay requirements are not met. This is worth five percent of your personality interview. This essay will also serve as a guideline for questions for your personality interview. Please be aware that the judges will judge this essay as an English paper would be judged. You may have someone of your choosing help you make the most of your paper. (Remember, in choosing your font size and style, that the judges should be able to read your essay easily) **ANSWERS MUST BE TYPEWRITTEN AND DOUBLE SPACED. THREE COMPLETE COPIES (Including this packet) MUST BE PROVIDED FOR JUDGES PACKETS.***

- 1. Tell the judges about yourself, your family, and who you are. Be sure to include travel, interesting information, etc. Let the judges know who you truly are*
- 2. Describe the community service activities that you have done.*
- 3. List your school activities (sports, clubs, class offices held, honors, and special training in music, dramatics, dance, and any other talents you may have)*
- 4. Hobbies and interests. List all your outside of school activities, in order of their importance to you. Include special awards won or accomplishments.*
- 5. What are your life's goals? (college, career, family and how you will continue to be a part of your community.)*
- 6. How do you feel about living in a rural community?*
- 7. What qualities should Junior Miss Tehama County possess? Why is it important to have a county representative in this age group? As our county representative, what would be your goals?*
- 8. Why have you entered the Tehama County Scholarship Program and what do you hope to accomplish during it?*
- 9. You may include One to Three letters of recommendation. This is optional.*
